## **AM session : Using Noteflight Learning Edition to meet your Music Goals**

*8:30 - 12:00* - Noteflight is a new online notation tool with great possibilities for music instruction at all grade levels elementary through college. Learn about the developing Resource Library for a variety of curriculum tasks, including instruction and assessment as well as online composition through your web browser with no additional software. About 12 teachers and almost 700 students from the Vermont MIDI Project have been using Noteflight Learning Edition since last fall as a pilot group. Together they've developed over 30 lessons for grade 5-12 music classes in the areas of general music, instrumental methods, choral ensembles and music composition/theory. These lessons are ready to use as is or edit for your own needs. In this session, you'll test out lessons already created and begin to develop your own content in this hands-on exploration.
